

What's Expected

For Parents

Parents play a central role in the Confirmation process at Glen Mar Church—this is not a drop-off program. We expect parents to meet the following requirements:

1. Attend a minimum of 4 of the class sessions with your child throughout the year.
2. Encourage, support and foster the completion of your child's confirmation assignments outside of class.
3. Talk with your child about the topics learned in class and discuss the questions in the weekly email, "Sticky Faith Conversation Starters."
4. Attend the class in place of your child if he/she is unavailable for a specific Sunday.
5. Participate in special activities.
6. Participate with your child in an individual service project.
7. Attend stole making with Friend-in-Faith during Spring Retreat (May 7).
8. Attend Dinner on Friday, June 2 and participate in the Service of Confirmation on Sunday, June 4.
9. Cover Confirmation cost of **\$155/youth**.

For Youth

We believe that to consider a life commitment to Jesus Christ, receive adequate preparation for Church membership, and be a real part of the class, each youth needs to meet the following expectations:

1. **Attend the weekly class sessions.** Excused absences include illness and possibly other situations discussed with the Confirmation Lead Team.
2. Attend the three retreats.
3. Attend the Confirmation Dinner, Friday, June 2 and Service of Confirmation on Sunday, June 4.

4. Be actively involved in Praising God, Growing as Disciples, and Serving the World.
 - Attend worship at least monthly (Glen Mar or other)
 - Assist with worship leadership one time during the year (lay reader, liturgist, usher, etc.)
 - Attend youth group or other church discipleship group at least 6 times
 - Complete assignments and memorizations.
 - Participate in one individual service project with your Friend-in-Faith.
 - Participate in one individual service project with your parent(s).
 - Participate in the class service project (March 4).
5. Relate to a Friend-in-Faith throughout the year.

For Friends-in-Faith

In an effort to provide opportunities for youth/adult interaction in the Confirmation process, each student will establish a relationship with an adult member of Glen Mar, **other than a relative or parent of a current Confirmation Student**. This person will serve as a guide, coach, mentor, advisor and friend. With these things in mind, the Friend-in-Faith will:

1. Contact the youth once a week to talk about class progress.
2. Attend the Friend-in-Faith Orientation on Sunday, Oct. 2 at 3pm.
3. Attend Safe Sanctuaries training if not up to date.
4. Pray regularly for the youth.
5. Meet at least monthly to talk about faith.
6. Attend a minimum of 4 class sessions with the youth throughout the year.
7. Participate with the youth in an individual service project.
8. Participate in stole-making with parents.
9. Attend the Confirmation Dinner on Friday, June 2 and Service of Confirmation on Sunday, June 4
