- Packaging meals for the hungry (5 years old and up)
- Decorating cookies for inner-city school teachers (5 years old and up)
- Writing letters and drawing pictures for service members and others (5 years old and up)
- Making spiritual bracelets for those in need of love and grace (5 years old and up)
- Sewing pillow cases for people during a hospital stay (8 years old and up)
- Making jump ropes out of clean old t-shirts for school children (8 years old and up)
- Making fishing kits and pony bead kits for children (8 years old and up)
- Assembling health care kits for families (8 years old and up)
- Knitting items for those recovering from an illness (8 years old and up)
- Making tic-tac-toe kits and flannel teddy bears for school children (8 years old and up)

- On-site food collection for the Sandtown community in Baltimore: non-perishable food items
- On-site collection of gently used coats, hats, socks, gloves, and blankets for the needy
- On-site collection of gently used shoes of any size for those in need of footwear
- Health screening (BMI and blood pressure screening, pre-diabetes risk assessment)
