What to bring:

- Instrument and accessories
- Folder or binder to keep sheet music. (Binder works the best)
- Pencil: this is more important than you think
- Music stand
- Music: Will be posted digitally. Please have your part printed before rehearsal.

Attire:

- Will be announced before concert.

Performances:

- These will be almost always be on Sunday. Generally you will play for both the 8 o'clock and 9:30 services.

Note to brass instrumentalists:

Every brass instrument at some point needs to empty excess water (a.k.a. spit) from tuning slides. If you do spill on the floor please clean up after yourself. During a performance in front of the congregation, some people may find it offensive to carelessly dump spit onto the floor of a church. It's a good idea to bring a cloth (microfiber works well). Doing this is more respectful and less work for everyone.
