Percentage Giving Chart

Stewardship as a spiritual discipline begins with percentage giving. By setting aside the first certain percentage of the resources that God gives us and giving it back to God, we discover what it means to celebrate his abundance more fully. By putting God first, we learn to depend on him, which is where true faith begins.

As you consider your pledge, use the chart below (or the steps on the opposite side) to identify what percentage of your income that you are currently giving to God's work in the world. Is it 10%? Is it 2%? Then, using the knowledge of where you are, prayerfully consider how you might grow in your giving. Could you increase your pledge by from 1% to 2% this year? Could you grow from 6% to 8% this year? Decide how many years you will take to reach your stewardship goal.

Faith is like a mustard seed, and so is the faithful practice of stewardship. Start small, and let it grow. Begin with a percentage gift of any size, and watch how your ability to trust God increases as your pledge as a proportion of your income increases.
