Each year, Glen Mar's Mission and Ministry Pledge Campaign asks for your support in order to fund our Operating Budget. This budget allows us to pay staff and pastors, utilities and other maintenance costs, and allows us to pay for things like worship costs, music needs, mission and service outreach, caring, discipleship, children and youth programming, and more. Additionally, every three years, we have a Capital Campaign that funds our mortgage payments for that three year period. This year, we are seeking to fund the Operating Budget for July 2023–2024, and the Capital Budget for July 2023–2026.

## What is our target for the Ministry and Mission (Operating) Fund?

Our Ministry and Mission Fund allows us to put our mission into action — to praise God in worship, to make disciples of Jesus Christ, and to serve our community and the world. To fully fund our annual operating budget, we have a target goal of \$1.5 million.



## What is our target for the Mission Possible: Capital Fund?

To fulfill our mortgage obligations, we need to raise \$1.9 million in capital commitments over the next three years.

Good news! If we get the commitments we need and have budgeted for, we will be able to eliminate the "smaller" mortgage note during this campaign.

This monumentous achievement would free up resources for more mission and ministry, and would help us in paying down our one remaining mortgage sooner than anticipated.

<sup>\*</sup>This represents a decrease of approximately \$200,000 from last year's goal. Although lower than previous years' goals, this amount will allow us to restore some earlier budget cuts due to cost savings we were able to find in other areas.

## How can YOU help?

Please note that Capital commitments must be used to pay down mortgage debt.

If you have been giving, but not in a committed way, please consider filling out an estimate of giving (some call it a commitment or pleage card). This allows us to have an idea of what to expect and is helpful for budgeting. It is not a contract, just a prayerful commitment. If circumstances change, just let us know.

If you haven't yet made giving a part of your journey with Glen Mar, now is a great time to start. We ask that you consider gifting a fixed amount per week, toward the Mission and Ministry (Operating) fund. Your giving will help you grow as a disciple and help us bless others. Together we will reach the goal!

#### **OUR MISSION IN ACTION**

### Because of your giving...


- Nearly 500 people participated in our MLK Day of Service, packing nearly 50,000 meals for our neighbors in Haiti. Writing hundreds of letters for shut-ins, helpers, and military, assembling hundreds of sewing, fishing, and health kits, and much more.
- Approximately 3,000 people attended our Journey to Bethlehem experience.
- We could return to Summer Concert Series, offer a Christmas Cantata, and a powerful Good Friday Cantata.
- Bell choirs, orchestra, and vocal groups for children, adults, and youth led in worship.
- We upgraded our database to Realm, which will help us communicate better and make our administration more efficient.
- Kids learned about Jesus in Sunday School, through family activities in Lent and Advent, the Easter Eggstravaganza, and Vacation Bible School.
- Mission Teams were sent to Hurley, Virginia and downtown Baltimore.
- · We hosted our Cold Weather Shelter for unhoused neighbors.
- We could send more volunteers each month to Grassroots Day Resource Center (serving meals, helping with laundry, etc).
- · We increased enrollment in our Early Learning Center.
- We fixed our controller for our HVAC system (which means it's not freezing or boiling in worship!).
- Adult Growth/Small Groups are growing, including: Disciple Bible Study, Adam Hamilton's The Call, Starting Point, other topical studies, and groups for all age groups and demographics.

### What we could do with more...

- Just as your grocery and utility bills have increased, so have our expenses. Even a small increase in giving would allow for those increases.
- We could give raises to our staff, who haven't had raises in four years.
- We could reach more people by increasing our livestreaming and hybrid ministry quality with needed tech upgrades. We could also hire a dedicated tech coordinator to equip and support our lay team.
- We could expand our community school partnerships, building relationships with kids and families in our neighborhood.
- We could take proactive care with our aging facility to steward and repair in a timely way — so that we can continue to bless our neighbors with what God has given us. We are planning to offer Pickleball, Farmer's Markets, Tutoring, Dance, and other Community Group Activities.
- Deeper partnerships with Ames Memorial and our other Baltimore neighbors to support hope, opportunity, and community.
- Additional mission trips, both locally and internationally.
