- You must be 12 years old and older to receive the vaccine (12 to 17-year-old must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian).

What you should know about COVID-19 vaccines (from Johns Hopkins Medicine):

- 1) Getting the COVID-19 vaccine can protect you from getting sick.
- 2) People of color are especially vulnerable to severe COVID-19.
- 3) Getting vaccinated for COVID-19 helps others in your community.
- 4) Although the COVID-19 vaccine development was fast, it did not skip steps.
- 5) The COVID-19 vaccine was tested in diverse populations to assess safety and effectiveness.
- 6) Side effects of the COVID-19 vaccine are temporary and do not mean you're sick.
- 7) The vaccines are safe and do not harm a woman's ability to become pregnant.
- 8) If you've already had COVID-19, getting the vaccine will add extra protection.
