Glen Mar Mission Ministry Code Of Conduct

In an effort to enable various youth activities to be as effective as possible, Glen Mar is establishing a Code of Conduct for all youth participating in any mission event. We expect all youth to maintain respect for all adult leaders, both those from Glen Mar and other adults leading the local activities. We expect all youth to follow and obey all rules and/or guidelines set forth by the local organization, and those set forward in this document. We expect all youth to bring honor to God, the Church, and themselves through their words and actions.

- 1. The use or possession of weapons, pyrotechnics (including lighters), alcohol or illegal drugs of any kind is expressly forbidden. Use of over the counter or prescription drugs is permissible only with the informed consent of the trip leader or designated helper.
- 2. Youth under the age of 25 are not allowed to drive a vehicle at any time on the trip, nor are they allowed to ride in a vehicle driven by anyone who is not a member of Glen Mar—unless given specific permission by the trip leader.
- 3. Youth will follow the dress code established by the sponsoring organization.
- 4. While on the trip there will be no hair dying, tattooing, or body piercing of any type.
- 5. Youth are permitted to bring cell phones, however, we want everyone to be "fully present" at all times; not focusing time and energy elsewhere. We want to build up the community of our group, and the community we're staying in. We trust that God is going to show up in a mighty way during our experience, and we want everyone to be alert and aware of it when it happens. Youth will be allowed to use cell phones at the discretion of the trip leader. Youth who abuse this privilege will have their cell phone confiscated. Adults will have cell phones available in case of an emergency.

The time to ask questions about any of these rules or expectations, or about the rules of the host organization, is before the trip. Clarify things in advance. Once you sign this document and depart on the trip it is too late to negotiate.

I have read this Glen Mar Youth Ministry CODE OF CONDUCT. I clearly understand what the expectations are for me and my behavior. I agree to abide by the conditions of the Code. I understand that should I violate any of the terms there may be consequences, such as the loss of privileges, free time, or being assigned extra work. Serious and/or repeated violations might result in my being sent home at my parents' expense.
