

top (folded edge)

I like to put the nose piece casing in before pleating- do what you prefer.
To put the nose piece casing on the inside, it should be down on this guide.
The directions are unclear if casing should be inside or outside.
If you accidentally put it on the the "wrong" side, it's fine. Just move on.

After sewing & turning, mask should be about the size of the gray box.
Place mask right side up in the gray box.
Center left to right, line up bottom with bottom edge.
Fold at the red solid line; bring down to the blue dotted line, pin.

Pleat pinning guide- Hopkins directions, step 5

I find I pin best in one direction. I like to put this guide on a clipboard, pin one side,
then spin the guide & mask 180 so I can pin the other side in the same direction.
The bottom of mask should still be lined up with the bottom of the gray box.

bottom (sewn edge) Always line up the bottom to make pleats.
